

# Painted Wine Glass

## Materials Included:

- Wine Glass
- Paintbrush
- Rubbing Alcohol
- Purple Enamel Paint
- Red Enamel Paint
- Turquoise Enamel Paint
- Gloves
- Paper Towels
- Cotton Swabs



## General Tips:

- Use a paper towel to wipe the glass down with a little bit of rubbing alcohol before painting to ensure that there are no fingerprints on the glass.
- Copy the paint work in the images displayed or freestyle and try something on your own.
- The type of paint provided is Folk Art Enamel paint. This type of paint is compatible with glass and ceramic surfaces when properly cured.



## Dotting Technique:

- Dip the non-brush end of the paintbrush into the paint to dot the paint on the glass. Experiment with larger and smaller dots to create a more interesting design.

## Make a Mistake?

- Use the rubbing alcohol and either a cotton swab or paper towel to clean off any unwanted paint marks.

## Finishing:

- To cure the paint, let air dry for 1 hour. Place in a cool oven, heat to 350 degrees and bake for 30 minutes. Cool in the oven and then remove.
- The paint is safe for the top rack of the dishwasher, but hand washing is recommended.
