

## Take & Make: Bird Seed Feeder

### What's Included:

- Bird Seed Mix
- Coconut Oil
- Popsicle Stick
- Twine
- Straw
- Paper Bowl

### What You Need:

- Microwave
- Scissors
- Ceramic or glass bowl



### Instructions:

1. Begin by placing the coconut oil in a ceramic or glass bowl. Place the bowl in the microwave and melt in 15 second intervals until completely dissolved.
2. Add the bird seed mix to the melted coconut oil and stir with the popsicle stick.
3. Pour the mixture into the paper bowl.
4. Next, add the straw to the center of the bowl, this will create a hole for the twine to go through. Wait for the mixture to set enough so the straw can stand up by itself but that the mixture is not completely hardened.
5. Let this fully set. You can place it into the fridge to speed up the process.
6. When the mixture is set, remove the straw and peel away the paper bowl.
7. Feed the twine through the hole created by the straw and tie a knot.
8. Hang on a tree to feed the birds!
