

Take & Make: Clover Centerpiece

Materials Included:

- Glass Jar
- Folk Art Multi-Surface Paint in 14 Karat Gold
- Foam Brush
- Metallic Green Vinyl Clover Stickers (created on the Silhouette Cameo 4)
- Faux Greenery
- Burlap Ribbon

Materials You May Need:

- Household glue or a glue gun
- Tweezers (optional)
- Wire cutters (optional)

Directions:

1. Clean and dry the glass jar.
2. Use the foam brush to apply a layer of gold paint to the jar. The first coat will be mostly transparent.
3. Apply multiple coats of paint allowing 1 hour to dry between coats. 4 coats of the gold paint should be sufficient to completely cover the glass.
4. When dry, apply the green vinyl clover stickers to the jar arranged how you like them. Using tweezers will make this step easier and also prevent the oils from your skin from getting on the stickers. *Be aware that the stickers are slightly different with some stems facing the opposite direction.
5. Use glue to attach the burlap ribbon to the top of the jar.
6. Use wire cutters to trim off 1-2 inches of the greenery stem or bend the stem to fit the greenery nicely inside of the jar. Enjoy!
