

Take & Make Sewing: Lavender Sachet

What's Included:

- Hexagon Pattern
- Embroidery Floss and Needle
- Fabric
- Dried Lavender Fill (mixture of weighted stuffing beads and organic dried lavender buds)
- One Bead
- Needle, Thread, and Pins (if hand sewing)

What You Need:

- Scissors
- Pen



Instructions:

1. Using scissors, cut out the paper hexagon pattern.
2. Using the pattern, trace 2 hexagons on the fabric and cut out.
3. Pin the two hexagons together, nice sides facing each other. Sew around the edge with a half inch seam allowance leaving a 1 ½ - 2 inch opening.
4. Once you have sewn the hexagons together around the edges, snip the fabric at the corners (but not the stitches) before turning your hexagon right side out. This will keep the fabric from bunching too much at the corners.
5. Use a pen or something similar to push the corners out.
6. Pour the dried lavender fill into the opening and then sew it up.
7. With embroidery floss, thread up through the center and wrap the floss around the outside, coming back to center on the back. Do this five more times until each point looks like a petal. Be careful to keep your fill even around the flower as you make each loop around the outside of the flower.
8. Once you have 6 petals, thread up through the center again, thread through the bead, and secure it to the center of the flower by threading back down through the center.



9. Tie off in the back.

10. Enjoy your lavender sachet!
