## Take & Make: Plantable Seed Paper

## **Materials Included:**

- Recycled shredded paper
- Small piece of recycled colored paper
- Mesh screen
- Packet of flower seeds
- "Plant Me" Gift Tag
- Piece of twine
- Folded Card Base
- 2 Scalloped circle patterned cardstock shapes

## Materials NOT Included:

- Bowl
- Blender
- Bath towel

## **Directions:**

- 1. Empty the shredded paper into a bowl. Tear up the piece of colored paper and add to the bowl if you want your seed paper to have a color. Add enough warm water to the bowl to cover the paper and allow the paper to soak for 15 minutes.
- 2. Add the paper and water mixture to a blender and blend until smooth to create paper pulp.
- 3. Lay the mesh screen over a folded towel and pour the paper pulp on the screen. Use a spoon, spatula, or your fingers to spread the pulp in a thin, even layer over the screen. You can spread the pulp into any shape you want. Gently press the pulp into the towel to absorb as much water as possible.
- 4. Sprinkle the seed packet over the paper pulp and gently press the seeds into it.
- 5. Allow the paper to dry overnight.

To make the gift tag, cut a circle shape from the seed paper and attach to the bottom of gift tag provided with a tiny bit of glue (not included). Attach the twine and add to a gift bag or present for a "green" accent.

To make the greeting card, cut a scalloped circle or other shape from the seed paper to fit between the 2 patterned cardstock shapes (see the sample picture above). Attach all the pieces together and attach to the card base with a small amount of glue (not provided).

To use the plantable seed paper card or tag, simply plant in soil in a pot or in the ground and water to grow beautiful flowers!
