

TAKE & MAKE: 2000S BEDAZZLED PUMPKIN

Supplies Included:

- Small white faux pumpkin (approximately 3"x3.3" in size)
- Sparkly green pipe cleaner
- Pumpkin leaf pattern
- 3"x3" piece of green felt
- Gems in various colors
- Aleene's tacky glue
- Toothpick (to apply glue to gems)

Supplies Needed:


- Sharpie or marker (to trace pattern on felt)
- Pencil (to curl pipe cleaner)
- Scissors
- Tweezers (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Trace the pumpkin leaf pattern onto the piece of green felt with a sharpie or marker.
- 2. Cut out the green felt leaf using a pair of sharp scissors.
- 3. Separate gems in shades of green from the other colors.
- 4. Use the toothpick to apply glue to the backs of the green gems and apply to one side of the felt leaf.
- 5. Set leaf aside and allow to dry.
- 6. Use the toothpick and glue to apply the rest of the colored gems to the white pumpkin.

 (*Optional Use tweezers to hold and apply the gems)
- 7. Wrap the pipe cleaner around a pencil to give it a curled shape resembling a pumpkin vine.
- 8. Once the leaf and pumpkin are dry, wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the stem of the pumpkin to secure.
- 9. Glue the leaf at the base of the stem to complete this sparkly, bedazzled 2000s inspired pumpkin project.
